

THE HOTEL

Superbly situated near the Victoria Harbour's waterfront in the fashionable Kowloon district of Tsim Sha Tsui, The Peninsula Hong Kong is the city's oldest and most legendary hotel – often referred to as the "Grande Dame of the Far East". The property debuted in 1928 in a beautiful six-story building. In 1994, an additional 30-story tower was added, which nearly doubled its accommodation inventory. While the hotel has long been a see-andbe-seen destination unto itself with eight restaurants and lounges, a sweeping luxury shopping arcade, and a decadent spa – its location also offers easy access, via railway, ferry, or helicopter to Hong Kong's myriad attractions.

ACCOMMODATION

The Peninsula Hong Kong's 300 elegantly appointed guest rooms include 52 suites, as well as two palatial, ultra-luxurious suites: the 210-square-metre Marco Polo Suite, whose lavish wood-panelled rooms once housed the hotel's original Presidential Suite; and the 377-square-metre Peninsula Suite, offering breathtaking harbour views from its private terrace and double-height windows.

All accommodation comes furnished with:

- A minimum of 54 square metres of space
- Complimentary high-speed WiFi
- Tablet technology in 11 languages

- Bedside electronic panels that allow lighting and temperature control with the touch of a button
- LED Blu-Ray HD flat-screen TVs with cable and audio/visual entertainment options
- Complimentary VOIP phone calls
- Executive desks with printers/ scanners and fax capability
- Deluxe marble bathrooms with walk-in showers, baths, wallmounted TVs and hands-free telephones
- Nail dryers

DINING

The Peninsula Hong Kong's eight distinctive restaurants and lounges — which include a Michelin-starred establishment — are among the city's top dining and drinking destinations:


- Gaddi's, where Hong Kong's glitterati have gathered to dine on sumptuous European fare, sip fine wines and cocktails, and enjoy nightly live music for over 65 years.
- The Verandah, serving an array of sophisticated buffet-style dishes for breakfast, lunch, dinner, and afternoon tea.
- Chesa, a cosy, romantic space reminiscent of an alpine chalet

 and one of the best Swiss restaurants in Hong Kong – offers traditional favourites like fondue, raclette, and handmade sausages.
- Spring Moon, Michelin-starred restaurant whose refined Cantonese cuisine, signature dim sum, and sleek atmospheric dining room have earned a prestigious Michelin star.
- Imasa, featuring all the culinary highlights of Japan – meticulously prepared sushi and sashimi, shabu shabu, tempura, sukiyaki – and warm, attentive service.
- Felix, a chic, Philippe Starckdesigned space, offering modem European dishes, specialty cocktails, and unparalleled topfloor views of Hong Kong's harbour and skyline.
- The Bar, a low-lit lounge for enjoying fine whiskies, spirits, and evening live piano jazz.
- The Lobby, one of Hong Kong's most iconic meeting places, where opulent décor and live jazz music has set the scene for light bites and Classic Afternoon Tea for over 80 years.

SPA AND FITNESS

A dazzling sanctuary encompassing more than 1,100 square metres, The Peninsula Spa offers some of Hong Kong's most luxurious and deeply personalised spa experiences. An array of Asian and European-inspired beauty and wellness therapies are offered here, in a collection of 14 serene treatment rooms. The fitness-minded can enjoy both a spacious gym with state-of-the-art training equipment, and a stunning, Romanesque 18-metre indoor swimming pool with sweeping views over Victoria Harbour. Spa facilities also include:

- Separate saunas, aromatherapy steam rooms, and relaxation lounges for men and women
- Six VIP couples' suites
- A sun terrace for lounging and sunbathing

BUSINESS AND MEETING FACILITIES

The Peninsula's multiple meeting and event venues, comprising more than 2,700 square metres of space, offer some of the most elegant and flexible function spaces in the city. The options range from plush private boardrooms to the alfresco, harbour-view Sun Terrace to the grand Salisbury Room and Foyer, where 300 guests can gather beneath glittering chandeliers and a trompe l'oeil ceiling.
